Registration Information

Team players & spares must be a paid up member of the Midland Lawn Bowling Club by May 22nd 2017.

Registration fee will be \$10.00 per person per season, to be paid prior to teams being drawn.

Dress code will be casual.

Rules of the League

1. Each team will consist of 3 players.
2. Team selection - skips will pick vice and lead for the season by a "DRAFT".
3. Start of any game, players can play any position, but must continue in that position for the duration of the game.
4. Report at 6:45 pm. Start at 7:00 pm, or sooner after announcements Games will be 10 ends.
5. Scoring will consist of 3 points for a win. Tied games play one extra end, no scoring points awarded. 2 points for a win. 1 point for a loss.. Maximum points for and against 15.
6. One dead end allowed per team per game. Each extra dead end will be penalized one point on the scorecard and record the end played. Bowls equal distance score one point each.
7. Scorecards will be turned in by skips at the end of each game. Team names to be put on the scorecards and signed by the skips at the completion of each game.
8. Jack will be set not delivered. The team winning the end will set the jack. Mat is to be put down before jack is set.
9. Teams requiring spares are to call Gary Butineau 526 5321 or 427 4048. The spares list will be kept on a rotational basis. Teams short of players will only be allowed a maximum of two spares per game. Two or more days notice should be given to arrange spares. No charge to the spares. Wherever possible spares will be used by position, i.e. lead / lead, vice / vice skip / skip.
10. In the event that a team only has 2 players that team will only deliver 8 bowls. The team with 3 players always have first and last bowl. The team winning the end will set the jack.
11. League champs' (names of permanent team members only) will be put on the trophy.
12. Protests, disputes or legitimate concerns must be submitted in writing. The committee members will meet and address the issue in question and notify the parties involved of their decision. The Committee's decision is final.
13. In the event of bad weather, the game will be completed the following week. Rained out games will be rescheduled.
14. No-show teams default the game and 3 points are awarded to the opposing team and 15 points for zero against.
